Congregational Reflection Groups

- Participants committed to study materials prior to meeting
- Engaging 6-8 Sisters, lay partners, DWA in reflection

Regional Discernment

- One Dominican Sister, lay partner and DWA from each congregation
- Engage in studying material and identifying key areas for action

Visioning

- Team of Sisters and lay partners develop draft of implementation plan
- Congregation leadership review
